

The National Education Museum Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia (UPI) was inaugurated by the Governor of West Java, H. Ahmad Heryawan, Lc. The construction of the National Education Museum is a form of UPI's responsibility as a university concerned about preserving the nation's cultural-historical heritage, especially in education. Museums generally exhibit collectibles from the past, but this is different from the National Education Museum UPI. This museum presents how education will be in the future because currently, education is forecasting.





The existence of the National Education Museum is expected to be able to become a vehicle for research centers, as well as learning media and learning resources. It can increase the competence of educators and learner insight in seeking to improve the quality of education and become a cultural tourism destination in West Java and National. Because basically, humans do not study the past but the future. This museum is one of the resources for visitors to be able to see the collection and be able to do something and various experiences, as well as to buy something as a keepsake. The National Education Museum, Universitas Pendidikan Indonesia, records the history of national education through "Leading and Outstanding" conservation, education and research, and recreation efforts.

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# **PSM UPI**

UPI Student Choir or Paduan Suara Mahasiswa (PSM) UPI is one of the UKM that is engaged in singing at the University level. PSM focus on developing students' interests and talents, especially in the field of singing. UPI PSM does not only appear in their internal campus. Apart from that, they also spread their wings to show off their teeth outside their campus. Some of the places they have visited include the University of Indonesia (UI) campus in Depok, Bali, Jambi, and even performed in Vietnam. As an identity, PSM UPI focuses more on folk songs. For example, Lir IIir (Java), Bulu (Sunda), Janger (Bali), and others. This folk song is indirectly to preserve the culture of every region in Indonesia.

UPI PSM Won 3 Titles at the First Rhapsodie Indonesia Choir Festival; they won a gold medal in the Folklore category. Second, winning the Grand Prix Winner title, and third getting a promising conductor. For this achievement, PSM is entitled to a ticket to participate in the 2019 Rhapsodie Indonesia Choir Festival Grand Prix, held in Bali. Other achievements by UPI PSM include the title of 2nd Winner in the 9th National Folklore Festival, Golden Diploma Level 3 in the Folklore category at the 4th Vietnam International Choir Competition, and others.

# KABUMI UPI



Initially, Kabumi, a Sundanese arts activity unit, was intended for all members of the Bandung IKIP extended family, so it was called "Keluarga Besar Bumi Siliwangi," and consisted of lecturers, staff, and IKIP family members. In 1998, Kabumi UPI was registered as part of the Technical Implementation Unit (UPT) of UPI Culture.

Following the UPI Rector's policy in 2011, Kabumi was designated as a Student Activity Unit (UKM) so that automatic membership was only for UPI students.

Kabumi's achievements in the country are numerous, including Participating in the "Bandung Martial Art Fest" event at Taman Ganesha Bandung in October 2010. The initiator and committee of "Angklung are The Music Of My Country" involving 2010 angklung players to revitalize the inauguration of angklung by UNESCO as an intangible cultural heritage belonging to Indonesia in Monju in November; They participate in various activities held on the UPI Campus, whether the Student Association event at the Department level or events held by the UPI Student Activity Unit (UKM). It's no wonder that this UKM that has existed for a long time still exists until now, both on campus, nationally, and even abroad.
